Courses listed by Country

BOLIVIA:

- <u>NRCSA Center: Spanish School Sucre</u>, Sucre, Bolivia (National Registration Center for Study Abroad)
 - Foreign language classes are taught entirely in the foreign language (immersion method).
 - All levels are welcome (beginner to advanced) unless otherwise specified above.
 - Levels: placement tests are used. If there is no full group at your level, smaller group or tutor may be given with fewer hours per week.
 - Tutor means one-on-one class (private teacher). Shared tutor means two-on-one.
 - Students/class is maximum people per class ... which may be exceeded by 1-2 persons due to level placement.
 - Texts and materials are over \$15 per level.
 - Class-hour is 45 to 60 minutes (Most universities use a 50 minute hour).

COSTA RICA:

The medical Spanish program in Costa Rica has 3 locations: Arenal, Turrialba, and Tamarindo. Flagship location is in Arenal.

ECUADOR:

- <u>NRCSA Center: Academia de Espanol Quito</u>
 - Specializes in teaching Spanish as a second language to foreign students.

Canopy Medical Spanish

• Canopy offers several options for anyone looking to use or learn medical Spanish, but primarily targets doctors and nurses.

- **Canopy Speak** is a language proficiency practice app developed for providers and frontline clinicians who need to communicate with patients with limited English proficiency and improve overall quality of care when calling an interpreter may be impractical. Users will learn and practice routine medical phrases in foreign languages and apply them confidently in patient-clinician scenarios.
- **Canopy Learn:** Bite-size modules crafted specifically for clinicians and staff to learn Medical Spanish.
 - \circ Includes 40 hours of instructional content broken down into simple 15-minute modules.
 - 36 lessons spread over three target proficiency levels that employ a proven learning-byspeaking methodology.
- **Canopy Quest** is also designed to help you learn medical Spanish, but it is designed as a game. It is helpful to pair it with one of Canopy's other offerings for a more well-rounded education.
- You can try Canopy for free, but continued use requires a subscription.
